Mystical Hope: Trusting in the Mercy of God

Study Book: *Mystical Hope: Trusting in the Mercy of God* by Cynthia Bourgeault (This small 99 page book can be ordered new or used online.)

When we encounter struggles and challenges in our daily life, we yearn for the good news of hope to pull us through our difficulties. As we journey through the wellsprings of hope, we're invited to grow in our understanding of how we perceive this gift in our lives. Do we see hope through the lens of desired results, or do we see it through the lens of trust? Cynthia Bourgeault, author of Mystical Hope, says, "In our usual way of looking at things, hope is tied to outcome: 'I hope I get this job' or 'I hope my mother gets well.' The Bible introduces us to a different kind of hope that has its source not in events but in the mercy of God, a lifeblood of compassion connecting our heart to God's heart and the heart of all creation." You are invited to come and participate in the weekly Contemplative Prayer group which will explore and study the book, Mystical Hope: Trusting in the Mercy of God. During each session, we will support one another in our pilgrimage of prayer and our search for a deeper understanding of God's gift of hope. Let us trust that in the search itself, we

open ourselves to God's transforming love.

April News from St. Cyprian's

A unique art event will be open to the public on Saturday, April 13, 2024, from 12:00 noon to 3:00pm in historic St. Cyprian's Church at 604 Johnson Street, New Bern, NC. The art exhibit at St. Cyprian's Episcopal Church will feature African American artists, whose canvases and other works will be displayed in the main worship space of the church, as sunlight streams through the beautiful stained-glass windows.

Artists will be present to discuss their works with visitors, and local artist Lee Hood will do a demonstration of his painting. In addition, the public will be invited to participate in an activity called, "Make Your Mark." Visitors will paint a section of a featured canvas with a sketched image that will combine by the end of the afternoon in a complete community painting!

"Family History is Local History" will be the theme for the children's art activity. Outdoors on the church grounds there will be "Sip and Paint" for kids, with easels and paints set up to paint their original work and kid-sipping drinks. Popcorn will also be available!

There is no charge for the Art Exhibit or "Sip and Paint" activity. Donations will be accepted for future programs and St. Cyprian's renovation fund.
