News From Saint Cyprian's

The African American Heritage and Culture Center, in partner-ship with St. Cyprian's Church, has begun setting up an office in the undercroft. Financial arrangements between the partnership provide for a nominal rental of the space, given that AAHC will only be using it for small amounts of time at first, and an even split of proceeds from events at at St. Cyprian's, net of expenses. The partnership aims to become the premier teller of the African American story in the New Bern area, grounded in St. Cyprian's story.
