Christ Church's Vestry met on Monday, June 19th, nearly everyone was present. Rebecca Leahey read a prayer from her child's favorite bedtime book of prayers. The Meeting commenced with the approval of the May 2023 Vestry Minutes and Financials. Howard Furnas and Tony Embry summarized the Vestry's chapter reading about Finance and Administration from our Vestry Resource Guide (Source: *The Episcopal Church Foundation*).

Paul gave his report, which included the following: the status of the Director of Music Search, which has been renewed; the work planned for the balcony; the upcoming Vestry/Staff Retreat on Aug. 25-26th to be held at Trinity Center; information relating to Sacred Sound & Space and a special thank you concerning the delightful music we enjoy every week by a handful of talented musicians, while we await the installation of the new organ!

Eight brief Ministry Commission Reports followed, including an update by the Grant Committee, which awarded 12 grants to New Bern non-profits for a total of \$12,245. The next Vestry Meeting will be held during the Weekend Retreat at Trinity Center on Aug. 25th.
