Saying Goodbye to the Organ

Next Sunday, June 18, will be our last with the organ we have affectionally come to call "Old Bessy." Our music at the 10:00am service will be triumphant and bold hymns that are best played on an organ. The closing voluntary (played after the retiring processional) will be a new twist on an old favorite.

After that concludes, we will have a "deconsecrating prayer" over the organ and a prayer of thanksgiving for the piano, which will carry us through until we get the new organ installed. If anyone wants to tickle some ivory afterwards, you're more than welcome to take a turn!

VBS starts tomorrow, June 12, at 9 am and runs through Friday, June 16. We'll be in full force with 78 kids (3 years through rising 5th grade) and countless volunteers. The church will be packed full of excitement and the Holy Spirit. We will kick off this year's VBS week with a Eucharist for Children and Young Families tonight in the Outdoor Chapel at 5 pm.

Our theme is "Find the Light." We will be learning about God shining light in the world and how the children can reflect it back. As you turn on lights around your house this week, we encourage you to say an extra prayer for these kiddos who will be exploring their faith.

Today's Gospel is about following Jesus. As we learn about God's light, we learn to follow that light to do God's will. Remember this in your prayers for our younger friends who are just learning about all of God's goodness, as well as the 35+ volunteers who will guide people toward the light of Christ.

Tuesday morning's Eucharist will happen at the normal time but in the Nave or main church. If you need to visit the church office during the week, please note that the kids are using all downstairs classrooms and most upstairs areas as well. The church will be open after 12 noon.

News from Saint Cyprian's -- June 2023

WORSHIP AT SAINT CYPRIAN'S

The service of Morning Prayer is offered in the main worship space at St. Cyprian's at 11:00 a.m., the first and third Sundays of the month. This month's remaining service will be June 18th. Entrance is by stairs at 604 Johnson Street, in the Historic District of New Bern. All are welcome.

WHAT WE HAVE LEARNED, WHAT WE ARE DOING

In the new collaboration between St. Cyprian's and the African American Heritage and Culture Center, the steering committee met to determine next steps. First priority is to set up an office for AAHC in one corner of the undercroft, as the AAHC has no permanent home. The collaboration is preparing to become the premier teller of the African American story in the New Bern area, grounded in St. Cyprian's story, which will begin with a videotaped public presentation in the St. Cyprian's nave.

BUILDING REPAIR AND RESTORATION

Much repair work continues in the lower (undercroft) level of the building. All windows on this level are in need of repair because of termite damage and wet rot. Two windows have been completely rebuilt. Others require new sills and re-glazing and painting. Work on the clergy office continues: stucco is being applied to the exposed brick walls. Baseboard molding has been installed and primed in the hallway and choir room.

The nave-level stained glass windows are protected with plexiglass. However, in a recent thunderstorm a piece of plexiglass was ripped and broken from the window on the Johnson Street side. At this time, we are getting an estimate to replace the plexiglass. This may also require repair to the window trim molding.
