

2024 Christ Church Trust and Outreach Grants

For the past number of years, Christ Church has made two separate Charity Grants to Local Non-Profits. The Christ Church Trust grants were distributed in the Fall, while the Outreach Grants (combination of Pumpkin Patch, Giving Tuesday, and Cookie Walk) were distributed in the Spring. These two grants are being combined with a common title: CHRIST EPIS-**COPAL CHURCH 2024 Trust and Outreach** Grants. There will be one common Grant Application Form for local charities to apply online beginning April 2nd. There will also be a common application deadline on April 30. This common deadline will apply to the Christ Church Trust and the combination of the Pumpkin Patch and Cookie Walk. There will be a single distribution to all charity recipients on May 31st.
