

Backpacks, Backpacks, Backpacks

How Can Christ Church Help?

Back to school can be a happy and exciting time for children and families, but it can also be a time of financial stress. For some families, the expense of purchasing school supplies and backpacks is simply not in the budget. This year, we at Christ Episcopal Church have the opportunity to help in a number of ways. You could buy a backpack, which will be donated to the **Episcopal Farmworkers Ministry** and filled with supplies collected by that organization. These backpacks will go to some of the 1,200 students who have requested assistance with purchasing school supplies this year.

Additionally, we continue to support **Interfaith Refugee Ministry** with their back-to-school drive. For twenty-four years we have been helping IRM with this ministry. We currently have 18 students signed up to receive much-needed school supplies and book bags.

To help the Farmworkers Ministry simply drop off a backpack to the church before **August 20th**, and we will see that it gets where it is needed. Designated funds will provide additional support for the effort to support EFWM.

To help IRM please choose a school tag, which lists the needed items. These tags are located by the school bus in the Reception Area. Please sign the form by the number on the tag to let us know which child you have selected and add your phone number. We ask that you return items on or before **August 20th**.

Many thanks for helping these children in beginning a new school experience. These donation deadlines coincide with our parish Blessing of the Backpacks event which is also on August 20.




