DID YOU KNOW: There are 25 Bells in the Carillon at Christ Episcopal Church, and they can be programmed to play up to 10,000 songs! Each bell is meticulously crafted by hand, cast only of bronze and composed of pure red copper and block tin (most bells are approximately 78% copper and 22% tin). The Carillon chimes each quarter hour and plays two hymns at noon every day.

## Women's Book Study

On Tuesday, August 5th, the Women's Book Study will begin reading *Acedia & Me* by Kathleen Norris. Copies of the book are available for purchase at the Reception Desk (\$10.00).

Norris is a poet and essayist whose work focuses on the intersection of religious practices and the spiritual journey. In *Acedia & Me*, Norris explores all aspects of acedia, with the particular purpose of drawing a distinction between it and depression. Acedia, coined the "noonday demon" by the early monastics, is a type of spiritual apathy, and is often described as a weariness of soul.

Join us Tuesdays from 10:00-11:00 am in the 2nd Floor Living Room. Women of all ages are invited to attend. We open our time together with prayer, followed by reading the book aloud, and discussing. No preparation is necessary. You can join the group at any time.

### Support Following Texas Floods

The deadly, early-July flooding along the Guadalupe River in Texas has a connection to Christ Church. Former member Leslie Jandrain lost her brother, John Burgess, his wife Julia and their sons Jack (5) and James (21 months). The Burgesses were camping and got caught up in the flash flooding in Kerr County. We prayed for them by name on Sunday in the Prayers of the People. To add to the tragedy, the family leaves behind an 8-yr old daughter, Jenna. Leslie and her sister-in-law Jennifer Anderson established a trust for Jenna.

The Jandrains relocated to Raleigh in 2015 for Jay's work. Leslie carried part of Christ Church with her to the funeral in Texas. She had two prayer shawls and the small, blue, butterfly processional cross to honor her nephews.
